Position Summary:

The Vehicle Maintenance Mechanic performs routine inspections, repairs and maintenance on vehicles in Monarch's fleet, to include snowcats, snowmobiles, loaders, passenger vehicles...etc. The essential functions of this position include:

- 1. Be an effective employee within the guidelines of department and company policies, procedures and values, in fulfillment of Monarch's mission statement to "provide our guests with a quality, personalized mountain experience."
- 2. Work in conjunction with other employees and departments as part of the Monarch team.
- 3. Perform the inspection, and basic repair and maintenance of vehicles in Monarch's fleet, including passenger vehicles, snowcats, snowmobiles, loaders...etc., as assigned.
- 4. Ensure that daily inspection logs and other checklists are legible, updated and current.
- 5. Communicate with equipment operators in other departments in identifying and clarifying equipment issues.
- 6. Maintain a good working knowledge of, and adhere to, all shop and safety procedures.
- 7. Keep vehicle inspection and other necessary logs updated in a legible and timely manner.
- 8. Inform Manager of shop supplies needed for reorder.
- 9. Other duties as assigned.

<u>Qualifications</u>: To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential function listed in this description satisfactorily, with or without a reasonable accommodation. The requirements listed below are representative of the abilities, education and physical demands required to perform the essential functions of this position.

Requirements Related to Knowledge, Skills & Abilities:

- 1. Ability to maintain a good attitude and work well with guests and other employees.
- 2. Ability to speak clearly and communicate in the English language.
- 3. Must have an awareness of surroundings and the ability to identify and respond to situational needs.
- 4. Ability to take direction and follow procedures.
- 5. Effective English reading and writing skills.
- 6. Knowledgeable in electronic and electrical components.

Requirements Related to Education, Certifications & Experience:

- 1. A valid CO driver's license and good, company insurable driving record required.
- 2. Some previous experience in heavy machine maintenance, repairs and operation is required.

Requirements Related to Working Conditions & Physical Demands:

- 1. Requires the ability to work any day of the week, Saturday through Friday and holidays, and overtime if necessary, as agreed upon by your superior.
- 2. Requires working at high elevation (over 10,000'), and with exposure to adverse weather conditions, such as severe cold, heavy snowfall, strong winds and intense sun.
- 3. Must be at least 21 years of age.
- 4. Requires ability to lift moderate to heavy (90 lbs.) loads.
- 5. Requires stretching, bending, grasping, reaching, shoveling and visual acuity.
- 6. Exposure to oils and chemicals likely (see JHAs).
